The Concerned Citizens for a Better Brooklyn and the Baltimore City Southern Police District encourage you to report suspected prostitution activities on your block by calling 911. You may also use this "SUSPICIOUS ACTIVITY NOTICE" to record instances where a vehicle is observed soliciting a prostitute or picking up a prostitute. Based on the information you provide, a letter will likely be sent to the registered owner of the vehicle indicating that the driver was observed either engaged in conversation with a known prostitute or was seen repeatedly driving through an area known to have a high instance of prostitution-related criminal activity.

Always put your own safety first. Gather information discreetly and never confront suspicious persons.
